The 2021 Getty Marrow Education Intern will support the creation of Art Stories, a new and innovative digital platform for engaging the Fowler's K-12, university, and general public audiences. The intern will focus primarily on supporting the planning and implementation of an art story by conducting research on pre-existing content created by the Fowler's Education and Curatorial Departments (exhibition texts, K-12 curricula and digital materials); assisting with outreach to community members, UCLA faculty and artists for creating story content; and participating in conversations with the Digital Education Advisory Committee, comprised of UCLA faculty and external advisors, as they define and evaluate the pedagogies, technology, and content for Art Stories.
